



Locum RADIATION ONCOLOGIST Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Program

The Opportunity

The Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Centre (SMRCC) provides comprehensive cancer care to residents living in the Simcoe Muskoka region. We are seeking a one year locum from March 2018 until February 2019.

The Position

The successful applicant will be a Radiation who will join our growing and dynamic SMRCP team of 8 Radiation Oncologists, 11 Medical Oncologists, 3 Gynecologic Oncologists, and a comprehensive interdisciplinary group of cancer care professionals committed to delivering exceptional cancer care to the residents of Simcoe Muskoka. The position is a locum 0.75 FTE Position; clinical experience with Gynecologic Cancer is preferred but not required. Deadline for application is December 17th, 2017. Anticipated start is March 1st, 2018.

The Centre

The SMRCC is located within the Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre (RVH). It has radiation treatment, systemic therapy, supportive care, surgical oncology, prevention, screening and clinical research programs for patients and their families living in Simcoe Muskoka. The current population served exceeds 450,000 residents. The radiation treatment program is equipped with 3 new Varian Clinac iX linear accelerators, each having VMAT, IGRT, stereotactic, and respiratory gating capabilities. A Philips Brilliance CT Simulator with Varian's Advanced RPM system provides both 3D and 4D treatment planning data. The paperless environment is supported by Varian's ARIA Oncology Information System. The RVH has a state of the art Imaging Department, an automated Laboratory Service, a expanded Surgical Program with 10 Operative Suites and a new Surgical Step down unit. Current program capital expansion includes a Regional Interventional Cardiac Program and a Child and Adolescent Mental Health Program.

The Location

The SMRCC and RVH are located in Barrie, Ontario, the gateway to cottage country. Barrie is a rapidly growing city located approximately 45 minutes north of Toronto and offers large city amenities with small town charm.
